### **BURSARY DETAILS**

If your parent works in the Hairdressing Trade *in Southern Gauteng* (Divisions 101 and 105), and you are interested in an A D Zakar Memorial Fund Bursary Grant to study further at a University or Technikon or Technical College, you are invited to fill out the attached Grant Application Form. (Students studying with loans or partial bursaries and/or final-year students are also invited to apply).

#### **WHO CAN APPLY?**

##### **REQUIREMENTS**

- You must be a South African Citizen;
- Only a child of someone engaged in Hairdressing in Southern Gauteng may apply;
- You must have matriculated;
- You should be an above-average or top academic achiever (70% and above);
- Admission to University/Technikon/Technical College.

**Note: Half-Yearly Reports of Student's progress must be submitted, where applicable.**

#### **COURSE OF STUDY**

University: any Degree

Technikon/Technical College: any Diploma

#### **PROCESS:**

1. Fill in and submit the Application Form to the General Secretary, along with all the documents as required under item 3, below.

2. You, together with your parent, will be called for an interview by the Grants Committee (which comprises the Chair, the Vice-Chair and the Secretary of the Council).
3. You must also provide:
  - 3.1 proof that you are the child of someone engaged in the Hairdressing Trade in the Southern Gauteng Region;
  - 3.2 Proof of costs from the institution for which the Grant is being applied for.

**Note:** *Payment will be made directly to the institution concerned.*
